## **Inevitable book**

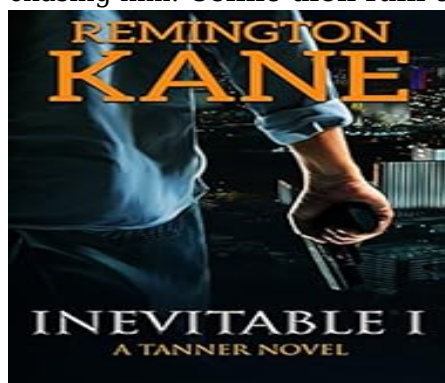
