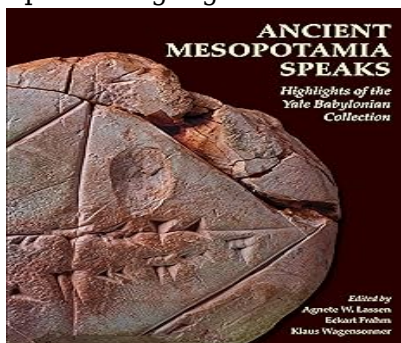


Ancient Mesopotamia Speaks: Highlights of the Yale Babylonian Collection By Agnete W. Lassen
