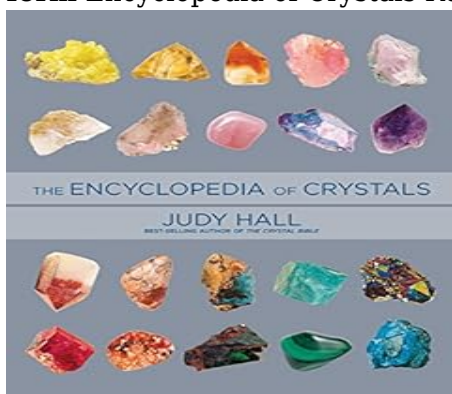

Perhaps there will be an encyclopedia volume 2 in due course much like the crystal bibles? The second disappointment was actually the lack of information given for each crystal! In some cases only a few short sentences!
