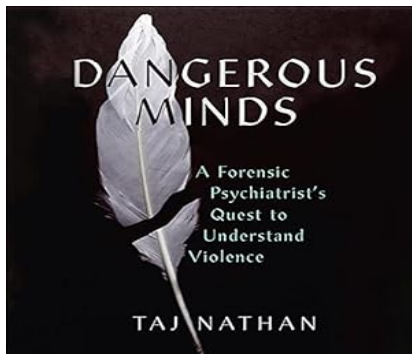


## Dangerous minds izle
