

Surly Romance (Billionaire Dads Book 2) By Nia Arthurs

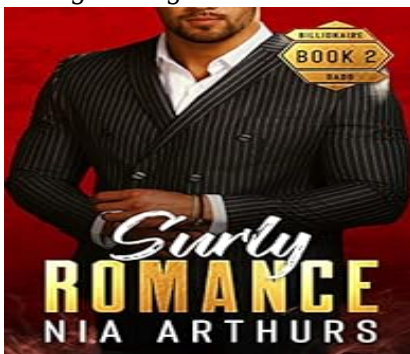

Central africa Sunita and Darrel's story is fraught with the grief sorrow secrets and insecurities that can easily sneak up and destroy happiness self esteem and relationships, Even as a trained psychotherapist Darrell misses a lot of queues that he has psychological scars and that he needs to learn better communication skills and to be open. Sunita while having a loving and honorable attitude towards her controlling mother so good! I was not disappointed with Darrel and Sunny's story. These two had a history that only Darrel was knowledgeable about because they met in high school yet Sunny doesn't remember Darrel (Hoodie Guy). Darrel is in the process of becoming the legal guardian to Michael and Bailey: When he hires an Interior Designer for the boys' rooms he has no idea it is Sunny until she shows up. These two are comical together but most importantly they care about Michael and Bailey and once Sunny connects with them they genuinely seem like a family already, Darrel has insecurities because of his dad but I am glad he put the needs of both boys first and did everything he could to secure their future with him: Their story stole my heart and I am glad Sunny learned the truth that it wasn't Darrel who betrayed her in high school. Two great characters and the romance is full of emotions but ends in joy. Darrel and Sunny's relationship did not just resonate with me in the same way Alistair and Kenya did: I already suspect the bad fraudulent Stinson brother is Beth's father, Central africa This is a terrific read with great characters an entertaining storyline and filled with drama twists suspense and plenty of steam: I think I connected so well with Sunny because of her being in the previous story my heart went out to her immediately, I'm glad she had the opportunity to show how she bravely rises above her predicament the good and not to good risk of doing so: Two great characters and romance with all the characters feelings and emotions this is just what I enjoy reading and looking for in the stories that I really appreciate: I was so excited to read this as Sunny got her own love: She had such a rough time as she was just starting out it's so fantastic to see how she help the boys to blossom: What a powerful combination of fun and heartfelt love that will fuel your romance, I thought both of these characters were amazing and together they are absolutely perfect: Oh what story it's fast paced and captivating and it will give you such feelings of love.
